- I. Worldly Hope vs Biblical Hope
  - A. Worldly/Natural Hope
    - It is a wish, a desire or an expectation that something will happen
    - 2. It is based on natural reasoning or logic
    - 3. There are no absolute guarantees always an uncertainty
  - B. Biblical Hope Romans 15:4
    - 1. Desire for something good to happen
    - 2. Expectation of obtaining what is desired
    - Foundation of Biblical hope is the Word of God and the Promises of God
    - There is a certainty and a guarantee because it is God's Word and His Promises - neither He nor they ever change! -Malachi 3:6; Numbers 23:19
- II. Biblical Faith & Biblical Hope
  - A. Biblical Hope has two components Romans 8:24-25
    - 1. It is future looks forward in time
    - It is invisible cannot see or experience it as a reality in my life right now
  - B. Faith and Hope Hebrews 11:1
    - True Biblical faith takes hold of the future of the unseen realm and it brings it back into the present to make it real or a reality so that we can do something with it in the present
    - 2. Faith is always present tense hope is always future
    - 3. To receive anything from God, it must come through or by faith not hope
  - C. Believing and Receiving Mark 11:22-24
    - Believing is present tense and continuous until it manifests itself - when faith becomes sight
    - 2. Two Requirements of Receiving
      - a. Believe now & continue to believe
      - b. Acting on that belief
