Lesson 3 - Supernatural Manifestations / Gifts

	Notes
Supernatural Manifestations of the Holy Spirit - I Cor. 12:7-10	
 Vs. 1 - "Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant (unaware - misinformed)." 	
 In original language, the word GIFTS is not there. The word is PNEUMATIKON (Gk) which means spiritual things or spiritual matters. 	
 Paul then explains what those spiritual things are in Vs. 4-6, he says: 	
◆ 4 There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. 5 There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. 6 And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. (NKJV)	
• Paul shows us three classifications:	
• Gifts - Vs. 4	
♦ Ministries - Vs. 5	
◆ Activities (workings, effects of the Holy Spirit) - Vs. 6	
First Classification - Gifts (Charismata)	
♦ Meaning:	
o A joyous grace gift	-
o Charisma means grace	
o A free gift - freely given	
o Given to every true Christian	
◆ Purpose of gifts	
 Given to every believer, a capacity or motivation for service so that the believer can build up the Body of Christ 	
Also, where the term "gift (charismata)" is used?	
o Romans 12:6-8: ⁶ Having then gifts (charismata) differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; ⁷ or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; ⁸ he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

♦ These gifts referred to in I Corinthians 12:4 are also found in Romans 12:6-8. They are:	
o Prophecy	
o Serving	
O Teaching	
O Encouraging / Exhorting	
O Contributing / sharing / giving	
O Leadership	
o Mercy	
Each Christian is given at least one charismata and may function in more than one, but this free gift motivates us to do something. That something is called MINISTRIES.	
Second Classification - Ministries (DIKONIA)	
◆ Meaning:	
o Ministry	
o Active service	
◆ Purpose of Ministry	
 To provide a function or ministry to serve and edify within the Body of Christ 	
Where are functions listed?	
o I Cor. 12:27-28: ²⁷ Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. ²⁸ And God has appointed these in the church: first <u>apostles</u> , second <u>prophets</u> , third <u>teachers</u> , after that <u>miracles</u> , then <u>gifts of healings</u> , <u>helps</u> , <u>administrations</u> , <u>varieties of tongues</u> .	
o Ephesians 4:11-12: 11 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ	
 Ten functions or ministries (appointed by God) 	
o Apostles	
o Prophets	
o Teachers	
o Miracles	

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o Gifts of Healings	
o Helps	
o Administrations (governings)	
o Varieties of tongues	
o Evangelists	
o Pastors (shepherds)	
 The Ephesians 4 passage is called the FIVE FOLD Ministry that Jesus established 	
Third Classification - Activities (ENERGEMA)	
◆ Meaning	
o Energy	
 Showing something or making something happen - mighty workings or operations 	
◆ Purpose of Activities	
 The energy of God - the operation of God is the Holy Spirit and He works through us 	
 What are these activities or operations? They are revealed as MANIFESTATIONS through the Believer's life. 	
◆ The word manifestation is PHANEROSIS (Gk) and it means to reveal; to show plainly by word or deed and thus the Holy Spirit uses the Believer to reveal something. The ENERGEMA of the Holy Spirit is made visible through a manifestation in the Believers life.	
◆ There are NINE manifestations - I Cor. 12:7-10:	
o Word of Wisdom	
o Word of Knowledge	
o Faith	
o Healings	
o Miracles	
o Prophecy	
o Discerning of spirits	
o Various tongues	
o Interpretation of tongues	
 ◆ These are manifestations — they are not gifts (charismata)

◆ Three general categories:	
o Revelation - Something revealed	
* Word of Knowledge	
* Word of Wisdom	
* Discerning of spirits	
o Power - Revealed through a demonstration	
* Gifts of Healings	
* Miracles	
* Faith	
o Inspirational - Something is spoken	
* Prophecy	
Various tongues	
* Interpretation of tongues	
 Purpose of manifestations 	
o Show that God is in control.	
o Elevate us above our natural abilities.	
o These manifestations enable ALL believers to contribute to the common good.	
O A BELIEVER SHOULD EXPECT TO OPERATE IN ALL OF THESE MANIFESTATIONS AS THE HOLY SPIRIT DIRECTS.	
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Manifestations of the Holy Spirit (we will only discuss two categories for the Altar & Prayer Ministry - Revelation &	
Power)	
Revelation Manifestations	
 Word of Knowledge - I Cor. 12:8 A Word of Knowledge - gives us facts. 	
o It is a supernatural impartation of facts to a person by	
the Holy Spirit.	
o It is a direct revelation by the Holy Spirit and suddenly	
you know something that you did not know before. o This impartation of knowledge can come in many	
ways:	
* Feel it – sense pain or discomfort in body.	
* See it – get a mental picture in the mind of	
problem.	
 * Read it – see a word or sign across a person. * Think it – Lord speaks a word to you

 * Say it – While talking or praying with a person, 	
you speak out the problem.	
* Dream it – have a vivid dream.	
* Experience it – open vision like a dream only not	
asleep.	
♦ Word of Wisdom - I Cor. 12:8	
o The Word of Wisdom is directive. It directs	
someone or something. It is given as a special	
ability to offer advice or guidance.	
o The Word of Knowledge gives us the facts, Thus The	
Word of Wisdom tells us how to use the knowledge	
properly. (Prov. 15:2 - The tongue of the wise uses	
knowledge rightly (NKJV). Wisdom is knowledge in	
action.	
 Wisdom is the right or proper application of 	
knowledge – we can apply knowledge with skill	
because through wisdom we see things as God sees	
them.	
◆ Discerning or Distinguishing of Spirits – I Cor 12:10	
o This is the ability, given by the Holy Spirit, to	
supernaturally look into the spiritual realm, to	
recognize, to identify, and to distinguish various	
kinds of spirits that are currently being manifested.	
O It is spiritual insight into the supernatural revelation	
of plans and purposes of the enemy.	
O It is the spiritual insight into where there are	
different spiritual beings:	
* Spirit of God – Holy Spirit* Angels – both good and evil	
* Demons – Principalities – Powers – Spiritual	
Wickedness	
* Human spirits	
 Discerning of spirits is not spiritual mind reading or 	
Spiritism, but rather the discerning of spirits.	
 Purpose of this manifestation is to open up the unseen 	
world and allow us to see what is happening so that we	
will be protected from deception.	
♦ It is a supernatural manifestation of the Holy Spirit	
which protects and guards our Christian life because	
Satan comes as an angel of light (II Cor. 11:14).	
o Examples: Paul & girl with spirit of divination – Acts	
; Paul & Bar-Jesus – Acts 13:6-10; Peter & Simon the	
Sorcerer – Acts 8:23	
Power Manifestations	
♦ Gifts of Healings – I Cor. 12:9 (plural – varieties of	
healings)	
o Notice – the word Gifts and Healings are both	
Plural. We're not sure why some translations use	

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the word singular "healing" because Greek Text	
shows it to be a plural noun - physical, emotional	
and spiritual.	
o 1/3 of the ministry of Jesus was healing the sick –	
people who were physically ill or diseased.	
 When this manifestation comes, we see God's divine power – what the Bible calls – "the power of 	
the Lord" present - "healing – in action".	
o Gifts of Healings are normally gradual – they take	
place over time – either hours, days or weeks, and	
the healing usually takes place within the physical	
body.	
♦ Working of Miracles – I Cor. 12:10 – (Literal translation	
is – works of powers) – Miracle is the Gk. Word –	
DUNAMIS - power/ability	
 Healings and Miracles are closely related but there are some differences. 	
O Healings are normally gradual while miracles are	
normally instantaneous.	
O Healings take place within the physical body while	
miracles are normally visible.	
o Miracles are sometimes creative - something you	
see happen before your eyes - like the lengthening	
of a short leg, or a new eye in an eye socket,	
replacement of a limb.	
 Miracles normally require some sort of act of faith and obedience so that the miracle working power 	
of God is released.	
♦ Faith – I Cor. 12:9	
O It is a supernatural faith – a special faith.	
O It is above any human level of believing and it is	
something that is imparted by the Holy Spirit.	
O The Manifestation of Faith is the supernatural	
ability to believe God without any human doubt,	
unbelief, or human reasoning.	
 You can believe for anything. Nothing seems impossible – you don't work it up. It is just there 	
and you find yourself saying things that you	
normally wouldn't say - because you really believe	
that they will come to pass if you just say it.	
o It is the ability to experience Mark 11:22-23.	
²² "Have faith in God," Jesus answered. ²³ "I tell	
you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go,	
throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in	
his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him (he will have whatever he	
says.).	
of those manifestations are superpatural in origin and

ability. They come from the Holy Spirit as He wills. God uses these to bring healing to believers and to non-believers.	
Everyone of these manifestations is available to each believer.	
♦ I Cor. 12:6 says - There are different kinds of working	
(manifestations), but the same God works all of them in all men.	
 Verse 11 says All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he 	
determines.
